# **Terrigal and Coastal Lagoons Audit**

### Engagement Summary

Between 1 December 2019 and 29 February 2020, Central Coast Council sought community input on the Terrigal and Coastal Lagoons Audit project which is a water quality monitoring project being undertaken in partnership with the NSW Government's Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (the Department). The community were invited to let Council know about any potential sources of pollution within the catchment area.

### Engagement Results

- 22% of the pins dropped related to Council infrastructure
- 8% related to private infrastructure
- 27% of the pins dropped were related to pump station smell
- 30% related to Gross Pollutant Traps and sediment
- 5% of the pins were in related to bush generation
- 5% related to the Dogs in open space
- 3% of the pins were related to flooding

#### What next

Investigations based on the information provided during the engagement period are continuing and will be incorporated into the broader audit process. To date, **15.7km** of inspections identified **3.61km** of sewer pipes in need of upradem of which **1.15km** has been relined. Council in collaboration with the Department are continuing with the Audit project and will continue to update the community on the results via
